WHEREAS, the tax revenues in the aforementioned budget are necessary and appropriate for funding the 2017 Parmer County budget, and

WHEREAS all other requirements under law have been met,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Commissioners' Court of Parmer County, Texas

That the 2016 tax rate per \$100 valuation for property within Parmer County shall be set as follows:

General Fund	0.4307
Farm to Market	0.1146
Debt	0.0290
Total	0.5743

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 7.03% AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$31.80.
